2 years' M.Phil. Programme in Teacher Education (2016-18)

And

Ph.D. Programme in Teacher Education (2016)

- **Number of Seats** :

M.Phil. - 15 (Fifteen), approximately

Ph.D. - 08 (Eight), approximately

(Reservation of seats as per Govt. of West Bengal Rules)

- **Eligibility** :

M.Ed. (with 55% or equivalent grade) along with P.G. degree in any subject (with 55% or equivalent grade)

Or

M.A. in Education (With 55% marks or equivalent grade)

With any one of the following

B.Ed. (with 55% marks or equivalent grade) and Honours degree in any subject.

Or

4 – Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (B.A., B.Ed. /B.Sc., B.Ed.) with 55% or equivalent grade.

(Relaxation of 5 marks in the eligibility criteria as stated above is admissible for the S.C. /S.T. /OBC(Non-creamy layer) /Differently abled candidates only).

And

Minimum 50% marks in written examination

- **Mode of application:** On-line (From 31 December 2016 to 14 January 2017)

On-line application fees

- Rs. 500.00 + Bank Charge (Rs.25.00) for applicants of S.C. /S.T. /OBC(Non-creamy layer) /Differently abled candidates.
- Rs. 1000.00 + Bank Charge (Rs.25.00) for all other applicants.

Admission Procedure:

Merit List will be prepared on the basis of academic score, and a written examination followed by an interview of the candidates short-listed from the candidates appeared in the written examination.

Candidates having both M.A. in Education and M.Ed.

Those who have both M.A. (Education)) and M.Ed., the percentage which is higher between the two will be considered.

Written Examination:

There will be a written test of 50 multiple choice type questions with full marks 50. Time for the test will be one hour and thirty minutes with negative marks of 0.25 for each wrong answer. The questions will be mostly on general Papers of B.Ed./M.Ed. Candidates securing minimum 50% marks in the written test will qualify for interview.

Exempted category

Candidates who have qualified NET, SET or any equivalent National Level examination and/or M.Phil in Education (with course work completion certificate) are exempted from the written test, but not from the interview.

Documents to be produced at the time of Examination:

No separate Admit Card will be issued. Candidates are to produce at the examination centre the printout of the On-line application along with the original bank receipt of the deposit of application-fees. They are also instructed to produce a Photo ID at the time of examination. The candidates are required to deposit photocopy of these three documents with full signature on all of them. S.C. /S.T. /OBC (Non-creamy layer) /Differently abled candidates who have submitted Rs. 500.00 as the application fee must submit self-attested photocopy of supporting document at the time of written test.

Merit List:

Final merit list will be prepared on the basis of Academic Score (Maximum 10 for M.A. (Edn) /M.Ed. and maximum 10 for B.Ed.) and Interview Score (Maximum 30).

Options for Ph.D./M.Phil:

The candidates from the merit list will be offered to take admission in the Ph.D. programme/ M.Phil. Programme in order of merit. (At the time of application the candidates will be required to opt for Ph.D. programme/M.Phil. programme. However, a candidate who has opted for Ph.D. programme will also be considered for M.Phil. Programme, if required).
